

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY OF CRESCENT COUNCIL MEETING February 2, 2015 THE CRESCENT CITY COUNCIL met in regular session in the Crescent Community Hall at 7:00pm pursuant to the law. Mayor Brian Shea called the meeting to order. The following Council members were present: Morgan, Beck and Hildreth, Anderson and Jacobsen.

MOTION BY BECK, seconded by Anderson to accept consent agenda. Morgan, Beck and Hildreth, Anderson, Jacobsen, all ayes. Motion carried.

B. Astleford/600 Johnson St. addressed the Council regarding this property. He is waiting on financing, and lining up construction people to re-do this house inside and out. Council did ask what his timeline was and it was stated that he would have paperwork by P/Z mtg. of Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> or by the next Council mtg. He had the shed applications with him. Council requested that all permits, financing paperwork and names of contractors be brought to the next mtg. to make this house habitable. Astleford stated he bought the house in 2008 and Council replied waiting 7 yrs. to upgrade this house is long enough. There was a motion made that if this paperwork requirement is not met, to start proceedings to demolish the house. That interior work could be done during the winter months, and as soon as weather allows the exterior could be completed. If things don't improve Council will look into demolition procedures. MOTION BY HILDRETH, seconded by Beck to start demolition procedures if the paperwork requirement is not met at the next mtg. Morgan, Beck and Hildreth, Anderson, Jacobsen, all ayes. Motion carried.

R. ADAMS/PARK BOARD reported that they are looking into ways to utilize the park. Tournaments, leagues, any activity. The concession will be open during the Fall Festival.

GALEN BARRETT/FIRE DEPARTMENT reported they are at 37 calls as of Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>.

CRAIG PETERSON/MAINTENANCE reported he had filled potholes just before the 1<sup>st</sup> storm. He has done ROW grading and removed the old hay bales from the fall festival. With the bobcat he has gone and straightened some driveway culverts. He put up NO PARKING signs on Mormon Brdg. Rd. in front of Casey's and put flags on the stop signs at the school. Removed a light pole at the park and will use for parking. 1550/1551 rescue vehicles had annual service done. He has spent a considerable amount of time snow-plowing. He is trying to get the wild land gear ready for spring when the grass fire start. 1585 needs work. He had to put the chains on the dump truck just to make certain areas.
