

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY OF CRESCENT COUNCIL MEETING August 3, 2015 THE CRESCENT CITY COUNCIL met in regular session in the Crescent Community Hall at 7:020pm pursuant to the law. Mayor Brian Shea called the meeting to order. The following Council members were present: Hildreth, Jacobsen, Beck and Anderson.

Jerry Mathiasen/PCCF was in attendance to take a few congratulatory pictures for the designated fund. MOTION BY Jacobsen, seconded by Beck to accept the consent agenda with bills. Hildreth, Jacobsen, Beck and Anderson, all ayes. Motion carried.

Clerk submitted a debt report to the council. This is an annual report sent to the state. This was just an FYI for council.

MARIALICE LEGGIO/SEPTIC addressed the council to request to have a septic permit vs. being mandated to hook up to sewer. Council stated that they want everyone hooked up to sewer regardless of the 200' rule, since council has done away with USDA rules when the City re-financed the loan. She has looked into various options and none of them are cost effective. She can't get any plumbers to come out to give her a bid.

Clerk instructed to check other avenues to find out about legalities, etc. and the council will get back with her.

RON OLSON/PERKINS UPDATE Ron reported that there are several discrepancies to this area of land and clerk and Ron are spending considerable time trying to sort it all out.

PARK BOARD had no report but next moving night will be August 28th at the Veterans Monument.

GALEN BARRETT/FIRE DEPT. reported that they are at 154 call for the year. Dept. has been doing Color Guard at all the tractor pulls and events at Westfair. New truck should be arriving earlier than expected, so now it may be Oct.

RON OLSON/PLANNING COMM. reported that they will be looking at the covenants for the Romeo land.

CRAIG PETERSON/MAINTENANCE reported he has been mowing ditches, sprayed the lagoon, Johnson St has been seeded from cleaning out the ditch. He assisted PeopleService in cleaning the lift station for the installation of the new pump that was done on July 30, 2015.

The City's west entrance sign has been put up. Few add-ons to complete it and it will be complete.

MOTION BY Beck, seconded by Anderson to adjourn the meeting. Hildreth, Beck, Anderson, Jacobsen, all ayes. Motion carried.
