

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY OF CRESCENT COUNCIL MEETING May1, 2017 THE CRESCENT CITY COUNCIL met in regular session in the Crescent Community Hall at 7:00pm pursuant to the law. This bill was discussed and decided to pay out of water savings acct and sewer money market acct. MOTION BY ANDERSON, seconded by Jacobsen to approve motion. Anderson, and Jacobsen, Hildreth, Adams, Powers, all Ayes. Motion carried.

MAYOR called for a moment of silence for the families of both the slain officer, Mark Burbridge and the injured officer, Patrick Morgan. Mayor reminded audience that Pat had been a councilman for the City.

The City will send flowers to both.

MOTION BY HILDRETH, seconded by Powers to approve resolution. Jacobsen, Adams, Hildreth, Anderson, Powers, all ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 1142017 Emergency Pool Procedures submitted for approval. MOTION BY ANDERSON, seconded by Adams to approve resolution. Anderson, and Jacobsen, Hildreth, Adams, Powers, all ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 1152017 Approving budget amendment submitted. MOTION BY JACOBSEN, seconded by Anderson to approve. Anderson, and Jacobsen, Hildreth, Adams, Powers, all ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUITON 1162017 Approving sheriff contract submitted. MOTION BY JACOBSEN, seconded by Anderson to approve. Anderson, and Jacobsen, Hildreth, Adams, Powers, all ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor appointed Randy Adams to oversee the pool. There will be an open house right after the pancake feed up at the pool. This will run from noon until 2PM.
