Morgan Hively has been approved to replace her. Park board still needs another member and volunteers. The track is done and Mindi is now getting quotes for benches that will be able to be engraved. Cost to be determined.

GALEN BARRETT/ FIRE CHIEF reported 119 calls for year. Pancake fundraiser for the fallen deputy and the injured deputy turned out to be a huge success. Over 600 people attended. One member has been hired by Council Bluffs fire department. His goal is still be on Crescent on his days off.
