WATER MAIN EXTENSION INFO given by Anderson. Maps and specs presented to Council. Anderson is asking for approval to send all information on to IDNR for approval. After IDNR approval then the City would follow up with the next step, getting agreements in writing for Romeo. MOTION BY STOKES, seconded by Morgan to send plans/specs to IDNR for their approval. ORDINANCE # 201213620 SIDEWALKS submitted for 1st reading. MOTION BY CLARK, seconded by Morgan to approve 1st reading. Anderson, Clark, Stokes, Morgan, all ayes. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE # 20129110 NO CHEATER PIPES tabled for rewording to include corrected deposit amounts. KRISTA SMITH/PARADE reported that the parade will be Sept. 22, 2012. No insurance form received. CLARK stated that he will send when a printer is available next week. ANDERSON stated that he wanted insurance form received no later than Sept. 1st, 2012

GALEN BARRETT/FIRE DEPT. reported that the dept. is at 168 calls for the year. BURN BAN is in effect throughout the county and the state.

RON OLSON/PLANNING COMMISSION reported that they have 1 bldg. application so they will have a meeting 8-13-12.

COUNCIL instructed clerk to send a letter to 1010 Valley Dr. reminding property owner that it is his responsibility for any erosion.

ANDERSON reported about the manhole project. It is 95% done. Costs came in well under budget. Clerk instructed to call Justin (Olsson & Assoc) for proper paperwork and then pay 80% of project. MOTION BY STOKES, seconded by Clark to approve 80% pay request. Anderson, Clark, Stokes, Morgan, all ayes. Motion carried.

ANDERSON reported on lagoon repair project. FEMA requested that engineering report be put in layman's terms for the people that will be reviewing the proposal. Olsson & Assoc. are working on this item.

Discussion on Johnson St. paving. Council told homeowner that bids came in too high and they are still researching. It more than likely will not be repaved this year. Maintenance man will be instructed to patch the holes. Homeowner reported street light flickering. Clerk instructed to call MidAmerican and report this. Homeowner also requested a dead end sign on his street. Clerk instructed to call Animal Control about a barking dog.

MOTION BY STOKES, seconded by Anderson to adjourn the meeting. Anderson, Clark, Stokes, Morgan, all ayes. Motion carried.
